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**Memorandum of Agreement (MoA)
Between
Department of Health Science, University of Leicester and
Department of Nursing, University of Tanjungpura**

By Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between University of Tanjungpura dan University of Leicester signed on 7 March 2015, This MoA is made by and between:

1. Department of Health Science , addressed at University of Leicester 22-28 Princess Road West Leicester LE1 6TP. United Kingdom and
2. Department of Nursing, University of Tanjungpura, addressed at Jalan Prof.Dr. H. Hadari Nawawi Pontianak 78124. Indonesia

School of Health Science, University of Leicester and Nursing program, University of Tanjungpura shall be jointly referred to as "the Parties" and severally as "the Party". Other parties involved and mentioned in this agreement are the following:

3. Department of Health Science, University of Leicester is one of five Departments within the School of Medicine which operates within the College of Medicine, Biological Sciences and Psychology. The Department is engaged in internationally competitive research across a wide range of topics, including epidemiology, medical statistics, public health, primary care, health services research, and psychiatry. The Department has a complement of approximately 140 academic, research and teaching, and administrative support staff and around 100 taught postgraduate students
4. Department of Nursing, University of Tanjungpura is within the School of Medicine. The department consist of bachelor degree in Nursing and Professional practice in Nursing program. The Department held academic courses, professional practice, research, and community services.

Purposes/Objectives

Departemen of Health Science, University of Leicester and Nursing program, University of Tanjungpura intend to cooperate in the program namely cooperation in both education and academic research with the terms and conditions set out in this Memorandum of Agreement (MoA).

The scope the collaborative ventures may include

- a. Faculty exchange or visiting faculty program for the purpose of collaborative teaching
- b. Collaborative research particularly in Multidisciplinary & Multi-method research and Diabetes Research Centre.
- c. Undergraduate student visit for professional and cultural enrichment
- d. Participation in professional meetings dan conferences
- e. Continuing education that contribute to professional development
- f. Continuing education and advanced training for specific program held by Department of Health Science with themes: Primary Care, Complex Chronic Physical and Mental Disorders, Neuroscience and Behaviour, and Social & Epidemiological Pshychiatry.
- g. Development of mutually beneficial academic and training programs;
- h. Reciprocal assistance for visiting academic faculty, staff and students;
- i. Coordination of such activities as joint research and transfer of technology;
- j. Exchange of documentation and research materials in fields of mutual interests
- k. Other programs of mutual benefits

Budget Activity

The specific terms, cost and conditions of each or activity within the collegial relationship will be negotiated and agreed to, in writing, with the signature of the authorized official (s) of the participating institutions, prior to the beginning of the program or activity. Neither institution accepts any obligation under provision of this general agreement in the absences of a separate agreement pertaining to the program nor activity as specified and undertaken in this provision.

Budget funds are used in the implementation of any program in cooperation is the responsibility of each and in accordance with the collective agreement. Funds resources are either from government grant or Tanjungpura University funds program.

Time Period

The period of this Agreement shall be from March 2015 to March 2020.

Substantial Involvement

The following substantial involvement of the Partner University is anticipated during the implementation of the agreement.

1. Department of Nursing, University of Tanjungpura and Departement of Health Science, University of Leicester will be involved in the monitoring of progress towards the achievement of program objectives during the course of the program. Monitoring activities will include but not limited to: site visits, periodic meetings and other measures necessary to monitor activities under this agreement
2. Department of Nursing, University of Tanjungpura and Departement of Health Science, University of Leicester will meet at the agreed or designated locations to review project progress, consultations, as appropriate

This Memorandum of Agreement is to be effective from the date of the signature affixed below for a period of five years, and can be terminated by either institution upon written notification
