



**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
UNIVERSITAS TANJUNGPURA, PONTIANAK  
AND THE DEPARTMENT OF ANTHROPOLOGY,  
UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN, ANN ARBOR**



This MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT is made between:

The Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences, Universitas Tanjungpura (UNTAN), having its main offices at Jalan Prof. DR. Hadari Nawawi, Pontianak, West Kalimantan, Indonesia,

and

The Department of Anthropology, University of Michigan, having its main offices at 101 West Hall, 1085 S. University Ave, Ann Arbor, Michigan, 48109 USA and conducting research at the Cabang Panti Research Station, and other locations inside and on the border of Gunung Palung National Park, West Kalimantan,

hereinafter jointly referred to 'The Parties'.

Establishing the basis for their further cooperation in accordance with the following:

WHEREAS. The Parties have explored areas of mutual academic interest and wish to further their common objectives in research and education,

RECOGNIZING:

1. The importance of cooperation in academic scholarship, scientific research, and training activities,
2. The mutual benefits to be gained through cooperation for promoting academic excellence, research cooperation, scholarly activities, and international understanding, and
3. The long-standing collaboration and cooperation of The Parties in academic scholarship, scientific research, and training activities, and

PURSUANT TO:

1. The existing Memorandum of Understanding for Academic and Scientific Cooperation between The Parties,
2. The prevailing laws and regulations in the Republic of Indonesia and The United States of America, and
3. The principle of mutual respect, friendship, and reciprocity,

HAVE REACHED the following agreement:

**Article 1**

**THE PURPOSE**

The objective of this Memorandum of Agreement is to:

1. Develop joint academic scholarship, scientific research and student training activities between The Parties and their direct affiliates (e.g., collaborators, students, field managers) in Gunung Palung National Park, and
2. Facilitate mutual understanding, cooperation, and collaboration between The Parties.

**Article 2**  
**CONFLICT OF INTEREST**

1. The Parties state that, as at the date of signing of this Memorandum of Agreement to the best of their knowledge, no conflict of interest exists or is likely to arise in relation to The Parties' cooperation under this Memorandum of Agreement.
2. If during the term of this Memorandum of Agreement, a conflict or potential conflict arises for one of The Parties, then the Party will immediately notify the other Party in writing of that conflict or potential conflict of interest.

**Article 3**  
**DISPUTE RESOLUTION**

Should any dispute arise between The Parties regarding the fulfillment of the rights or obligations of any part of this Memorandum of Agreement, The Parties will resolve it under the spirit of cooperation, mutual respect, and friendly resolution.

**Article 4**  
**INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS**

Should any academic or popular media publications result from this Memorandum of Agreement, the text will explicitly recognize and acknowledge the collaboration and cooperation between The Parties. Following accepted international standards, co-authorship will be considered to either of The Parties who contribute substantively to the publication, including:

1. study conception and design,
2. data collection,
3. analysis and interpretation of data, or
4. drafting or writing portions of the article.

In the event that a joint publication is created, each co-author retains the independent right to use or license the use of the publication in an independently created work without requiring the consent of the other party.

**Article 5**  
**SCOPE OF INVOLVEMENT**

This Memorandum of Agreement applies to The Parties and direct affiliates working under their auspices. This includes:

1. Students and faculty from UNTAN and
2. Students, collaborators, and field managers associated with Andrew J. Marshall's ongoing research in and around Gunung Palung National Park.

**Article 6**  
**AMENDMENT**

1. This Memorandum of Agreement is open for amendment provided The Parties mutually agree to do so.
2. Any proposed amendment should be submitted by one party to the other in writing; the receiving party will respond in writing within six weeks to inform the sender party whether they agree or disagree to the proposed amendments.
3. Should the proposed amendment not be agreed to by the receiving party, the Parties will meet to discuss the continuation of the Memorandum of Agreement.


**Article 7**  
**COMMENCEMENT, RENEWAL AND TERMINATION**

1. This Memorandum of Agreement goes into effect on the date of final signature by both of The Parties.
2. This Memorandum of Agreement will be renewed automatically on an annual basis and in accordance with prevailing regulations.
3. If either of The Parties wishes to withdraw from this Memorandum of Agreement, notification must be sent to the other part in written form at least two months prior to the proposed date of withdrawal.

The withdrawal of one party shall not affect any on-going activities instituted under this Memorandum of Agreement prior to the termination of the Memorandum of Agreement.


